Mount Allison University and the University of New Brunswick provide a rebate to students from NB to ensure their tuition increase is limited to 2%. Saint Thomas University is the exception to this 2% increase rule. There was a prior agreement to allow the university to "catch up" to tuition rates at the other universities. This allows St. Thomas to increase tuition by 3% of the NB average (excluding St. Thomas) until 2017-18.

³Nova Scotia offers students who are residents of the province a credit rebate on their tuition up to \$1,283; These rebates are not deducted from the tuition fees presented.

⁴ Mount Allison charges \$500 for tuition in the first year and \$250 in the second.
