NOTES

- 1. In 2008 Nova Scotia made a change to its Grade Primary cut-off age, which resulted in about 2,100 additional students becoming eligible to start school a year earlier and a corresponding one-time bump in the number of high school graduates in 2021. This change affects many of the measures presented here.
- 2. The number of students with gender 'Unknown' enrolled in Nova Scotia and Prince Edward Island universities increased substantially in 2021-2022. This change impacted the participation rates by gender (see Table 5). As a result, the data have been supressed.
- 3. The National participation of Canadians has increased by 3.2 percentage points since 2007-2008 (see Table 3). Part of the increase could be due to <u>colleges transitioning to universities</u>, particularly in British Columbia, Alberta, and Ontario.
