Who graduates with **Humanities**, **Arts and Social Sciences** degrees?


41% of **Maritimers**


43% of non-**Maritimers**

Employment Rate	85 %	87 %	89 %
% Working Full-Time	81 %	78 %	31 %
Job requires university education/management	34 %	53 %	41 %
Job related to studies/program skills used	62 %	68 %	60 %
Earnings (median)	\$36,000	\$39,999	\$18,651
Full-Time Earnings	\$37,524	\$43,619	\$40,000

Transition still underway for many:

Two years after the first degree, 66% had pursued further study, with more than one-third still in school
